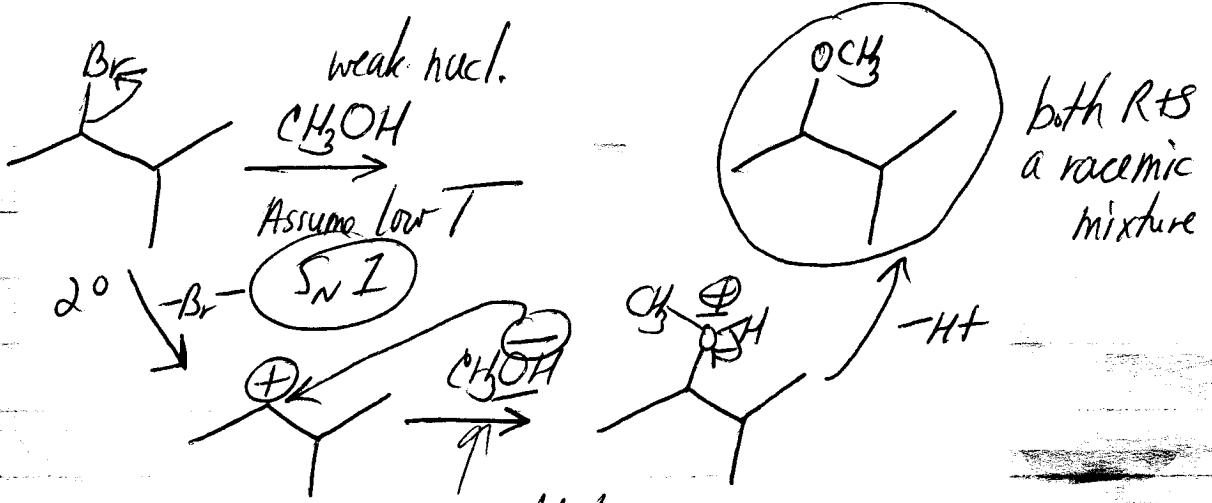


Acid/Base Rxn

 Normal alcohols will not.

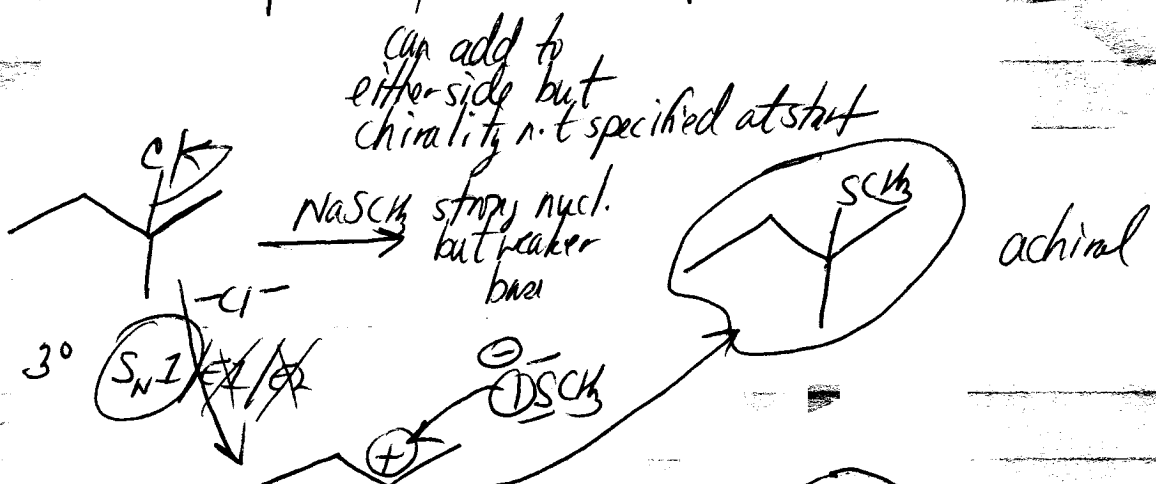




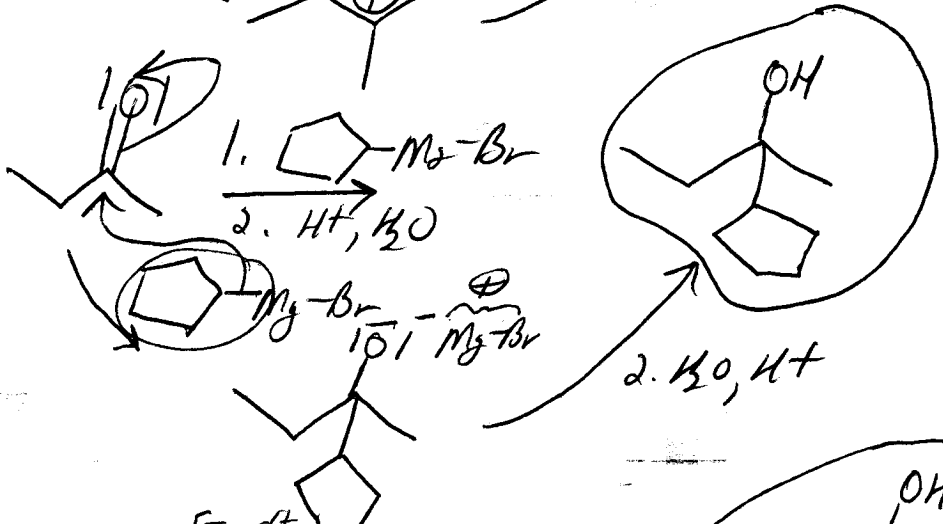

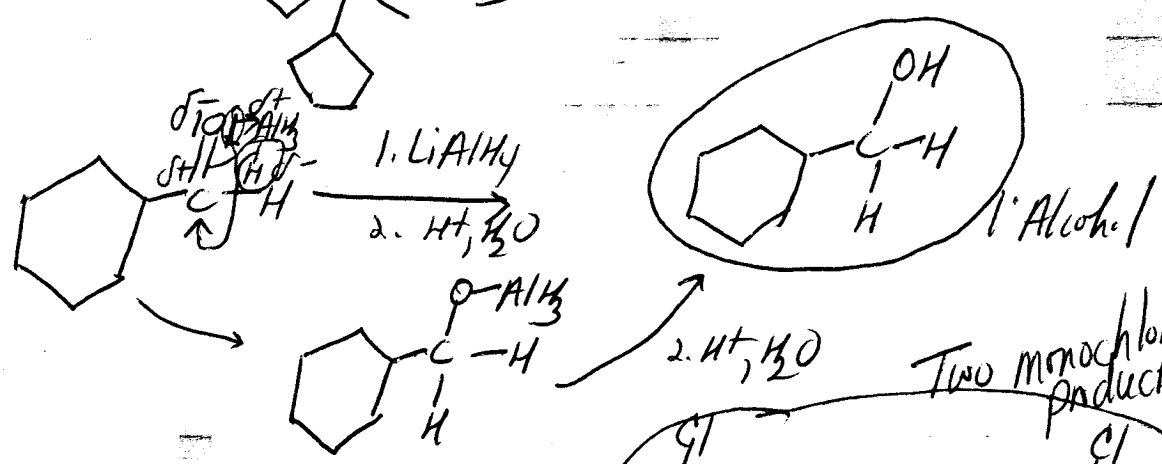
